

Born in January 1962 in Bucharest, Romania. **Dragos Seuleanu** is the Knowledge and Technology Transfer Department Coordinator, Cluster of the Extreme Light Infrastructure - Nuclear Physics Center (ELI-NP), Magurele, Romania. Since 2013, he has been the Chief Executive Officer of the Magurele High Tech Cluster (MHTC), the cluster objective being to transfer advanced research results from the ELI - NP Center to the business community.

From 1990, he was a journalist and top manager at the public radio. Between 2000 and 2005, he was President - General Director of the Romanian Broadcasting Society (the national public radio station). He was a member of the Administrative Council of the European Radio and Television Union.

He was elected vice-president and interim-president of Romania's Chamber of Commerce and Industry. He is the president of the Foundation for Democracy, Culture and Freedom. He is a founding member of the Center for Interethnic Relations and Social Relations of the Romanian Academy and Transparency International Romania. Between 1990 and 1996, he was an honorary adviser of the Romanian Academy President. He was the president of the Advisory Committee for Innovation of the National Authority for Science, Research and Innovation.

He graduated from the Academy of Economic Studies, Faculty of Management, in 1985 and specialized in the strategic management of national public radio stations, attending courses at the Voice of America, BBC, and Deutsche Welle. Between 1992 and 1994, he attended the Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA) courses initiated by ASE and the University of Washington, Seattle, USA.

Dragos Seuleanu is an Economic Sciences and International Economic Relations doctor at ASE, Bucharest. He supported the theme: A novel business model of the large-scale scientific infrastructures enhanced by public communication. Between 1985 and 1990, he was an associate researcher of the Technical-Scientific Terminology, Economic Semiotics, and Social Communication Collective coordinated by Acad. Ion Coteanu and Prof. Dr. Constanta Barboi to the Romanian Institute for Linguistics.

The President of Romania awarded him the Order of Faithful Service in the rank of Knight. He is an honorary citizen of Sighetu Marmatiei Municipality. In 2003, he became Adjunct Fellow of The Center for Strategic and International Studies (USA). Dragos Seuleanu received the Honorary Diploma from the International Press Institute (Vienna, Austria).
